Shikumen is a special architectural style which integrates the eastern and western cultures found in the traditional residential building in Shanghai. This kind of building shows the uniqueness of Shanghai in a way of fusing East and West and presents the inclusiveness and fashion sense of Shanghai. It almost has been the miniature and portrait of Shanghai since its opening for hundred years which is familiar to the world. Therefore, we choose this special architecture to be the bottle shape of our miniature this time. It also has another meaning by showing that we should not only focus on collecting foreign miniature liquor, but also need to pay attention to the Chinese one, so that the scope of our collections will be more diversified. Liuli (coloured glaze) is also the earliest glass art in China. The choice of this material can also emphasize the long history of Chinese culture.

- 3) Specially order the Glenfarclas 15 years Single Malt Whisky from Glenfarclas Distillery (United Kingdom); 399 limited bottles
